FEP O-rings are made up of an elastomer energising core encapsulated in a seamless jacket made from fluorinated ethylene propylene. Designed for use in static applications such as in pumps. Resistant to almost all chemicals, liquids and gases. FEP also has low compression set properties. Temperature resistance with a silicone core is -60°C to +204°C and with a Viton core -20°C to +204°C. Many standard sizes are available with very short lead times and

almost any size O-ring can be produced with a fast turnaround. Complies with FDA, USP Class VI, EC1935/2004, 3A and ADI-free.
